

Guideline for Open and Fun Show Awards Program

2017

1. The guidelines are the same for both Fun Shows and Open Shows except where noted.
2. You must be a current member of FDCTA in good standing. Your dues must be paid and the liability forms signed. Forms and checks must be filled out and received before your first competition.
3. A horse and rider are considered a team. The same horse with a different rider may also be considered a team, and can enter the same level, or another level.
4. A horse and rider team may only receive an award at one level for the current year even if they sign up for and ride two levels.
5. If a horse and rider team have previously won a division from a prior year, they cannot be considered for the award at that level. The team is expected to advance. You may ride the tests at any level but will not be eligible for the year-end award.
6. Open Awards entry forms need to be sent to the Awards Chair along with a \$15.00 entry fee, postmarked before your first competition. Fun Show Awards entry forms may be mailed to the Awards Chair (postmarked before your first competition), or turned in to the show secretary at the first show you attend. There is no entry fee for the Fun Show awards program.
7. For Open Shows, you must submit three scores of 58% or better from three different "L" Level and above judges. For Fun Shows, you must submit two scores of 58% or better from two different judges. One of the qualifying scores must be from the highest test offered in the level.
8. You must submit your scores to the Awards Chair by October 31st of the current year. A copy of the front of your tests with the judge's signature and name of the horse and rider is mandatory.
9. The scores will be calculated for year-end awards by adding the percentage scores. The highest number wins the award. Any scores submitted that are less than 58% will be discarded. Awards will be presented at the clubs year end banquet.
10. Protective headgear and boots with a heel must be worn. Proper bits are also required.
